Fund donated by Reformed Churches in the Netherlands & Ark Aid

A. RELIEF

1. Introduction

The civil war that began in Mid-December 2013 continues to affect millions of people in South Sudan. The humanitarian situation has been deteriorating more with fighting which erupted again earlier last July, 2016 between the government and opposition armed forces in Juba. Military confrontations and insecurity continue to escalate contrary to the spirit of the agreement signed. More people are being forced to flee from their homes and abandon their farms. Many are facing famine in different parts of the country.

Based on UN updated Report March, 2017

- **3.8 million** People displaced by the conflict including **1.1 million** who fled to refugee in the neighboring countries
- **218,653** civilians seeking safety in six UNMISS bases (Protection of Civilians).
- **6.5 million** people severely food insecure
- **90000** people facing famine.

Generously, two Reformed Churches in the Netherlands and Ark Aid have promptly responded by donating sum of **Euro17390** equivalent to **USD\$18086** as a relief emergency response.

2. Beneficiaries

With the donated relief fund, basic food items were bought and distributed at Mangateen, Juba South Sudan. **185** households totaling to **2150** beneficiaries (**950 adults & 1200 children**) were reached with basic food items. The beneficiaries have benefited from the food provision. This emergency response has saved lives; stabilized food security gaps and improved health situation.

3. List of food items distributed

1. Rice
2. Maize flour
3. Beans
4. Cooking oil
5. Milk powder (only for family with young children below 6 year)

Each household received a ratio consisting of (10 kilos of rice, 2 bag of maize flour, 10 kilos of beans, 5 liters of cooking oil plus a can of mild powder to the households who have children below 6 year old.

4. Target Groups and Beneficiaries

The beneficiaries who were targeted and served were composed of the most vulnerable groups like children, single female headed households, widows, disabled and aging persons.

B. BETHEL FENCE

Sum of **SSP 347,500** equivalent to **USD\$2045** has been designated to fence Bethel SRC property at Mangateen, Juba. Bethel SRC is first SRC church plant in Juba which was started in late 2010. The fence erection is meant to cover the front part of the property. The fence has two metal gates.

C. VEHICLE FOR EVANGELISM/MISSION

Since the only two owned SRC vehicles were looted in 2013 in Juba, SRC had been experiencing a lot of logistical difficulties and challenges in carrying out her activities effectively. Graciously, with some of the donated fund, a used Nissan Pick-up vehicle has been purchased to meet SRC growing logistical demands. SRC has been praying for a vehicle since 2015. The prayer has been answered and the need met!

D. SCHOOL PIT LATRINE

SRC in early, 2017 initiated a primary school as emergency response to meet the educational needs of the children of Internal Displaced Persons (IDPs) in Juba. SRC used Bethel worship shade to start the school. SRC property at Bethel has no latrine facility. Thus a pit latrine was constructed to provide a good hygienic atmosphere for the school as well as to the church. The school suffers from lack of water.



E. OTHER NEEDS MET

Sum of **SSP459,000** equivalent to **USD\$2700** were used to meet some key priority needs of SRC ministry:

- i. SRC Rock of life land purchase (40x40 ms) in Aweil (USD\$500). Half of the fund needed to purchase the land were raised locally and the aforementioned amount was topped to complete the land purchase.
- ii. Sum of (USD\$600) was designated to support evangelism initiatives at Ombada SRC Khartoum
- iii. Loving support to 32 pastors/evangelists (USD\$1600): SRC pastors and evangelists are laboring in areas of high risk and they do not have any salaries from their congregations due to the ongoing conflict and humanitarian situation in South Sudan. The above mentioned amount was given to them to meet some of their essential needs. Each was given sum of SSP8,500 equivalent to USD\$50 as a loving gift in appreciation of their sacrifices that they are making in prompting Reformed witness in South Sudan and Sudan. This is the first support of its kind that have benefited SRC leaders in their labor in the kingdom service.
